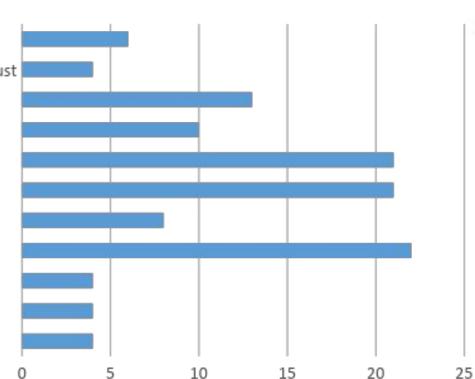

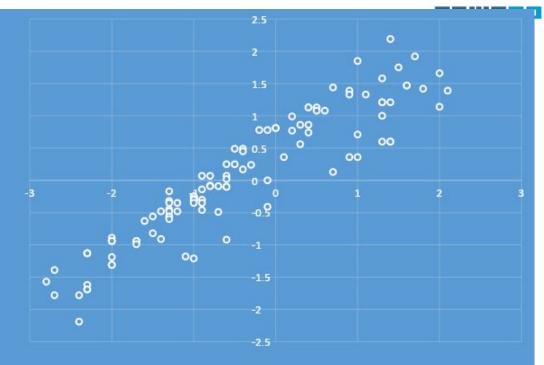

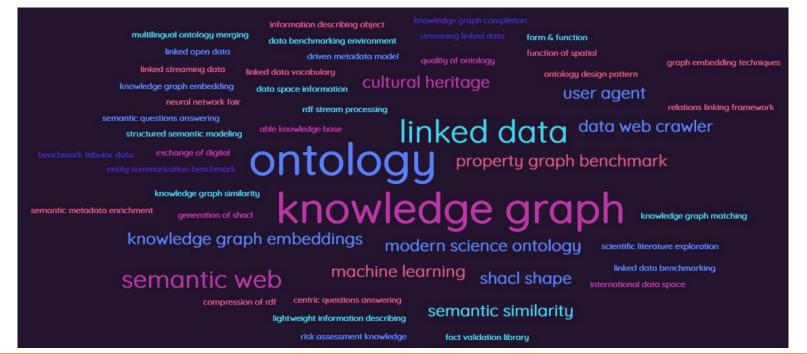
- 31 submissions

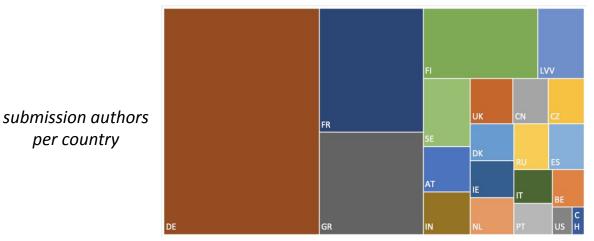
